- Whether you are in compliance or will become compliant through our program we will work with farmers to apply for funding to replace Tier 0-2 engines.

THE CURRENT DEADLINES IN THE AIR DISTRICT REGULATION 11-17 REQUIRE REGISTERED TIER 0 AND 1 ENGINES TO BE REPLACED BY DECEMBER 31, 2020 AND THAT TIER 2 ENGINES TO BE REPLACED BY DECEMBER 31, 2025.
